

# **Spark Your Future Scholarship Program**

This scholarship program is designed to provide tuition assistance to those pursuing an education in welding. The criteria outlined below have been designed to give the Scholarship Awarding Committee maximum flexibility in awarding the scholarship. Recipients will be selected without regard to race, sex, color, creed, religious preference, age, national origin, or disability.

### **Eligibility Criteria:**

To be awarded the scholarship, students must:

- Enroll in the Professional Welder or Welding Specialist programs at any of the StrataTech Education Group schools after 7/29/2024 with an expected start date in August 2024;
- apply for all applicable state, agency, and/or federal student aid;
- demonstrate financial need as determined by the financial aid application process;
- complete a Spark Your Future Scholarship Request Form;
- have no lapse in proper registration; and
- maintain all aspects of Satisfactory Academic Progress.

### **Award Process and Rules**

- Eligible Programs are Professional Welder (PW) or Welding Specialist (WS).
- Each student must complete a Spark Your Future Scholarship Request Form.
- Scholarships are not transferable or renewable and cannot be used in conjunction with any other institutional scholarship.
- Only one award will be given per student. If a student is eligible for multiple scholarships, the scholarship that is most beneficial to the student will be awarded.
- The maximum scholarship amount will not exceed \$3000 of tuition charged.
- Scholarships will be awarded upon successful completion of their program.
- Scholarships are based on the enrolled student's start date. If a student changes their start date, the scholarship award may be forfeited.
- Scholarship eligibility requires continuous enrollment. Termination from training may result in the loss of this scholarship.
- Scholarships may be limited and will be awarded on a first come, first-served basis.
- Students must achieve and maintain a 2.5 GPA and 80% attendance.
