

STEG Legacy Scholarship Program

In recognition of StrataTech Education Group Schools' graduates, STEG is presenting the opportunity for graduates to refer their friends and families to attend a STEG program. This need-based scholarship program is designed to provide tuition assistance to eligible students with demonstrated financial need based upon their difference between available resources and funding eligibility relative to their educational costs. The criterion outlined below has been designed to give the Scholarship Awarding Committee maximum flexibility in awarding the scholarship. Recipients will be selected without regard to race, sex, color, creed, religious preference, age, national origin, or disability.

Eligibility Criteria

To be awarded the scholarship, students must:

- be referred by a STEG (TWS/RSI) School graduate;
- be enrolled in one of our educational programs with at least 25 weeks of expected enrollment;
- enroll after November 19, 2024 with a start date in December 2024;
- be a U. S. citizen or permanent resident;
- apply for all applicable state, agency, and/or federal student aid;
- demonstrate financial need as determined by the financial aid application process;
- have completed the financial aid process and been issued an award letter;
- complete a Scholarship Request Form; and
- have no lapse in proper registration or break in attendance.

Awarding Process and Rules

- Students must enroll after November 19, 2024 with a start date in December of 2024.
- Students must apply for and accept any applicable state, agency, and/or federal student aid (other than PLUS), before requesting consideration for this scholarship program.
- Scholarships are not transferable or renewable and cannot be used in conjunction with any other institutional scholarship.
- Only one award will be given per student. If a student is eligible for multiple scholarships, the scholarship that is most beneficial to the student will be awarded.
- Scholarships will be distributed incrementally over the length of the entire student's program.
- Scholarships are based on the enrolled student's start date. If a student changes their start date, the scholarship award may be forfeited.
- Scholarship eligibility requires continuous enrollment. Termination from training may result in the loss of this scholarship.
- Scholarships will be awarded on a first-come, first-served basis with a maximum of \$2,000 for eligible applicants.

Any student meeting the scholarship criteria may apply. This scholarship program is based on the enrolled student's start date and demonstrated need as identified on the offer letter. This scholarship is not transferable.

Students must complete this request form and submit it to the Scholarship Committee to be considered. Of the requests received, each will be reviewed for completeness and accuracy of all information provided. Of those eligible requests, the awards will be distributed on a first-come, first-served basis and may not exceed \$2000.

There are a limited number of scholarships to be awarded per start date. If a student changes his start date, the scholarship award may be forfeited. Only one scholarship may be awarded per student. The scholarship will be applied incrementally to the student's account over the entire length of the student's program.
